FLU CLINICS AT THE STUDENT HEALTH CENTER

University of New Haven's Health Services provides health care for UNH students. Health Services is equipped to attend to the most common illness and will refer special cases to offsite physicians.

With the change of season comes the increased likelihood for illness. The best way to protect yourself and others from the flu is to get vaccinated. The University of New Haven's Health Services will be partnering with a local pharmacy to provide flu clinics. In most cases the vaccine will be FREE, just bring your Medical Insurance Card with you. Call the Student Health Center to select the date that works best for you.

Check the end date on your I-20!

If you will not complete your program by the end date on your I-20, you must apply for a program extension BEFORE your I-20 expires. Do a degree audit and submit the I-20/DS-2019 Program Extension form found on [myCHARGER](#) to the ISO.

Traveling for break? Be sure to have a travel signature!

If you have plans to travel internationally, make sure that you have a travel signature from an advisor in the ISO on page 2 of your I-20. There is a 3-5 business day processing time, so you must plan ahead!

Are your friends and family planning to visit the U.S.?

If you have family or friends applying for a visa to visit the U.S. to attend graduation, you can request a visa invitation letter from the ISO. Go to ISO page on [myCHARGER](#) and click "Forms, Letters, and Requests"

SMOKING LAWS IN CT AND ON CAMPUS

As of Tuesday, October 1st, a new law regarding smoking went into effect in the state of Connecticut. Businesses will no longer be able to sell cigarettes, cigars, chewing and pipe tobacco and vaping products to people younger than 21, which is up from the previous age of 18.

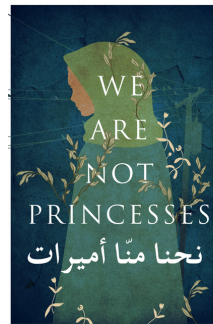
