Social Security Card/Denial Letter

Applying for a Social Security Number (SSN)?

- Only nonimmigrants with proof of work authorization and a job offer may apply for a SSN.
- Employment letters must include a start day. Social Security cannot accept offer letter without a start date.
- A student must apply within 30 days of the start day on their employment letter.
- For OPT (Optional Practical Training) students, you must wait to apply for a SSN until the "Valid From" date on you EAD (Employment Authorization Document). Department of Homeland Security will not be able to verify your status before that date.

When do you need a Social Security denial letter?

If you are applying for a Connecticut Driver's License or State I.D. and do NOT have a job, you must apply for a SSN denial letter in order to have a license issued.

The ISO requires one week preparing a Social Security letter.
